



#### **HCV/S8 PROGRAM**

Salutations from the Harlingen Housing Authority HCV Section 8 Program!

I hope everyone had a blessed and joyous Spring season. As we prepare for the summer months, the Harlingen Housing Authority would like to thank all owners participating in our program.

Owners and landlords are very important to the Housing Choice Voucher/Section 8 Program as they help provide safe, decent, and sanitary shelter to families who qualify for HCV/S8 Vouchers. Owners' responsibilities are essential to the HAP contract, lease, and HUD regulations.

#### The owner is responsible for the following:

- Performing all management and rental functions for the assisted unit, including selecting a voucher holder to lease the unit and deciding if the family is suitable for tenancy
- Maintaining the unit following Housing Quality Standards (HQS), including performing ordinary and extraordinary maintenance
- Complying with equal opportunity requirements
- Prepare and furnish the PHA information required under the HAP contract
- Collecting from the family any security deposit, the family rent to the owner, and any charges for unit damage by the family
- Enforcing tenant obligations under the lease and paying for utilities and services unless paid for by the family under the lease

The Housing Authority has implemented Direct Deposit on all Housing Choice Voucher/S8 rental and utility payments to landlords and tenants.

We have teamed up with US Bank to offer debit cards. With US Bank ReliaCard, it's fast, safe, and easy. Signing up is free; no credit check or bank account is required to receive this card. It is easy to sign up! Please stop by our office to pick up an enrollment form. If you prefer to use your bank account, that is no problem. Please stop by the office to bring us the bank information to set you up.
